**PLEASE NOTE :** All Birds to be presented for Auction this year must be exhibited in the Show and entered in the auction by placing a "X" beside the bird you wish to auction, in the column provided on your entry form.

If you wish to place a reserve on a auction bird please place the reserve price in the auction column on your entry form. Following Judging on Saturday all auction birds will be benched separately prior to the Auction commencing for viewing.

We do stress that all exhibits put forward to auction must be of a HIGH exhibition quality or be of Stud/ Breeding quality. Birds below those standards will not be accepted for Auction

### CATALOGUE AVAILABLE ON THE DAY

Vendors please Note : All nominations for Auction close with your entries Monday 30th June 2014 to enable a catalogue to be printed.

A small percentage of each sale (20%) will go as commission to The NSW Silkie Supporters Club Inc ,the remainder to the seller.

Payment to vendors will be made on the day at the completion of the sale.



# RULES AND CONDITIONS

1. The NSW Silkie Supporters Club Inc Inaugural Club show event will be conducted under the guidelines of the Model Rules as presented by the Department of Fair Trading UNTIL SUCH TIMES AS an alternate CONSTITUTION IS adopted.
2. The NSW Silkie Supporters Club Inc is not affiliated with the EPA so will not be relying on the Rules and regulations pertaining to that association regarding the running of the show.
3. The NSW Silkie Supporters Club Inc Show is being held in conjunction with the Annual Show of The Langshan Club of NSW in the same pavilion but a separate show.
4. The Judges decision will be final. No protest will be allowed.
5. Each section/class will be conducted behind ropes for the convenience of the judge. No one is permitted to walk down the aisle while the section is roped off.
6. No exhibitor is to remove or handle birds from its pen unless accompanied by an official.
7. Champion bird shall not come from a breeding pair, novice class or junior class.
8. Should any bird/exhibit appear affected by any sickness or ailment, it will be removed from the pavilion.
9. The greatest care will be taken with all exhibits, but The NSW Silkie Supporters Club Inc will not be held responsible for any accident, loss or damage arising at the show. The exhibit being the sole responsibility of the exhibitor/owner.
10. No bird/birds are allowed to be fed, removed or handled, or cages opened once judging commences.
11. The Secretary/Treasurer may exercise his/her rights under the Constitution to refuse any entry or membership fee thus rendering such applicant unfinancial.
12. Insurance cover is held by the club and underwritten to the extent of \$20 million for the 12 month period commencing 1/3/14.
13. All birds must have access to water, if you choose to remove the water before judging it must be replaced after the completion of judging & photos.
14. The group will provide new water containers for all exhibits. These are to be the only containers used while judging. If you choose to use your own containers they must be removed prior to judging.
15. Entry Fees- \$1.50 per entry for members and \$2 per entry for non members.

**PLEASE NOTE: The above members entry fee rate is only available to financial members of The NSW Silkie Supporters Club Inc. Membership of The NSW Silkie Supporters Club Inc Facebook group does NOT in itself entitle exhibitors to the members' rate.**

**Club Membership Fees:-** \$20 per person or family, payable with entries.

All monies are to be made payable to The NSW Silkie Supporters Club Inc.

16. The NSW Silkie Supporters Club Inc Annual show is conducted as an open show, both club members and non financial members are welcome and eligible to exhibit their Silkies.

**PLEASE NOTE : The NSW Silkie Supporters Club Inc has included additional colours on the show schedule ( development colours). Those being Black Crested Partridge, Black Crested Grey, Fawn Breasted Partridge male (pullet breeder) and Splashed. These colours are to be exhibited & Judged to the following standards.**

**FAWN BREASTED PARTRIDGE MALE(pullet breeding male)– Male: Plumage: Colour and markings as for a partridge male but the black breast replaced with a fawn/reddish brown coloured breast.**

**BLACK CRESTED PARTRIDGE- Male & Female: plumage: Colour and markings as for the partridge Silkie but crest colour replaced with solid black. Standard Partridge for Black crested and normal partridge should be as per the correct requirement for Black breast in the male.**

**BLACK CRESTED GREY– Male & Female: Plumage: Colour and markings as for the grey Silkie but crest colour replaced with solid black.**

**THE SPLASHED STANDARD HAS BEEN ADOPTED FROM THE AUSTRALIAN NATIONAL PEKIN CLUB Inc**

**SPLASHED– Male & Female: Plumage: a mixture of slate blue & white that has a faint bluish tinge. The blue in the feathers in the form of large irregular-shaped blobs as distinct from V ticking. Main tail feathers and primary wing feathers have lesser amount of blue than the rest of the plumage. Undercolour: Slate blue and sooty white evenly distributed. Blue splashes to comprise no more than 50% of the plumage.**

**AOC**– Must state colour when entering and that colour must have an approved colour pattern Standard provided.

**PARTRIDGE**- Standard for Partridge males: Black crested males and standard partridge males should be as the correct requirement of a Black breast in the males.

**NOVICE EXHIBITORS** – Must be those who have never won a first prize in the open section of any silkie show or have less than three years showing experience.

**JUNIOR EXHIBITORS** - Must be 16 years of age or under and must handle and pen their own birds for exhibition on the day unless sent by long distance with another fancier.

**PENNING** - The pavilion will be open on Friday 4th July from 4pm-8pm. Saturday 5th July from 7am. All birds to be penned by 9am sharp.

**UNPENNING** - Will commence at the completion of auction & presentation. Approximately 3:30pm. All birds will be stewarded out.
